- Carpene Malvolti Rose NV (Valdobbiadene, Italy)**  
Maraschino cherry in a bottle, a sparkling Pinot Nero that's not too sweet and not too dry.....\$2 / 6 / 12
- Mumm Cordon Rouge "Jubileum" (Champagne)**  
Meyer lemon and citrus nose with great acidity and a mineral and brioche finish.....\$2.75 / 8.5 / 17
- Mulderbosch Rose 2008 (Stellenbosch, South Africa)**  
Round and mellow GSM with crisp acidity and candy apple and strawberry flavors.....\$1.5 / 3.5 / 7

### Crisp & Minerally Whites

Delicately balanced Italian white, crisp and dry, light fruit, elegant and distinctive.....\$1.5 / 3 / 6

- Alamos Chardonnay 2007 (Mendoza, Argentina)**  
A fantastic wine that combines ripe tropical fruit aromas with a rich full-bodied mouth feel a great value.....\$1.5 / 3 / 6
- Ferrari Carano Fume Blanc 2007 (Sonoma County)**  
Floral notes of wild flowers and citrus with a bright and wonderfully lively acidity that jumps from the glass.....\$1.50 / 4 / 8
- La Greffiere La Roche Vineuse 2007 (Maconnais)**  
True expression of Chardonnay, beautiful minerality and acidity frame the light fruit notes and subtle perfume.....\$1.5 / 4.5 / 9
- Catena Agrelo Vineyard Chardonnay 2007 (Mendoza)**  
Impressive white Burgundy with rich mineral undertones and an elegant and distinctive finish.....\$1.5 / 4.5 / 9
- Sonoma Cutrer Chardonnay 2006 (Russian River Valley)**  
Perfect example of Russian River Chardonnay, crisp and lean with good mid palate flavors of lemon citrus.....\$1.5 / 5 / 10

Red cherry and lavender aromas with a bright fruity body and a clean minerally finish.....\$1.5 / 3.5 / 7
- Bliss Family Vineyards Pinot Noir 2007 (North Coast)**  
Brimming with aromas of Black Cherry and plum followed by layers of toasty oak, cola and wild Raspberries.....\$1.5 / 4.5 / 9

Lush Spanish red made from Old Vine Grenache and a touch of Syrah balance, dark fruit flavor and a touch of oak.....\$1.5 / 4.5 / 7
- Vinosia Primitivo IGT 2006 (Puglia, Italy)**  
Zinfandel's cousin from the Puglia region of Italy. Rich and robust flavor with a ripe fruit forward style.....\$1.5 / 4 / 8
- Juan Gil Monastrel 2006 ( Jumillia, Spain)**  
This Mourvedre is loaded with flavor, personality and charm delivering loads of complexity and flavor.....\$2 / 4 / 8
- The Barrel Blend Red Wine 2005 (Napa Valley)**  
Classic Napa Meritage smoothly produced by the Hill Family, a Merlot/Cabernet blend with a touch of Syrah.....\$1.5 / 4.5 / 9

A joint venture between Chateau Laffite and Argentina's Catena winery, an elegant blend of Cab and Malbec.....\$1.5 / 5 / 10

Old vine, head pruned Grenache with a nose of black raspberry, blueberry finishing with dusty tannins.....\$2 / 6 / 12
- Tenuta Casabianca IGT 2004 (Tuscany)**  
A blend of Sangiovese and Cabernet with lots of old world charm, cherry fruit, leather and vanilla smoke.....\$2 / 6 / 12
- La Spinetta, Barbera Ca' Di Pian 2006 (Piedmonte)**  
Bouquet is rich and complex, with hints of plums, violets and berries, flavors of liquorice, blackberry marmalade and a underlying smokiness.....\$2 / 6 / 12
- Teatown Merlot 2004 (Napa Valley)**  
A truly great Merlot that has a real silky texture with gobs of dark fruit and chocolate and spice.....\$2.5 / 7 / 14

### Big, Full-Flavored Reds

- Dante Cabernet Reserve 2006 (Oakville)**  
A Bordeaux blend of predominately cabernet, smooth and round in texture with mocha and dark chocolate.....\$1.5 / 3 / 6
- Klinker Brick Syrah 2005 (Lodi)**  
A nose of cotton candy, vanilla and hints of orange peel with rich bright flavors of cassis, cherries and chocolate.....\$1.5 / 4 / 8
- Clif Family Vineyards "Climber" Red 2004 (North Coast)**  
Raspberry, nutmeg and cedar aromas. Predominately Cabernet Sauvignon with a little bit of everything else in the balance.....\$1.5 / 4.5 / 9
- Heartland Shiraz 2005 (South Australia)**  
Powerful black fruit character in a rich spicy smooth package. Big but well-balanced. A winner.....\$1.5 / 4.5 / 9
- Rosenblum Contra Costa Zinfandel 2006 (Mt. Diablo)**  
Produced from 100 year old head-pruned vines, rich and spicy with voluptuous plum and cherry flavors.....\$1.5 / 5 / 10
- Conn Creek Limited Reserve Cabernet 2005 (Napa valley)**  
Rich true Cabernet character a reasonable price with the characteristic cedar and spice box notes.....\$1.5 / 5 / 10
- Nicolis Valpolicella Seccal 2004 (Veneto)**  
Produced in the Ripasso method, this wine exhibits aromas of dried fruits and a ripe spicy fruit quality.....\$2 / 6 / 12
- Cascabel Tipico 2006 (McLaren Vale)**  
Classic Aussie GSM from a small producer. Big ripe fruit with traditional European styling, Chateaufeuf-life.....\$2 / 6 / 12
- Summers Cabernet Adriana's Cuvee 2004 (Napa Valley)**  
Classic Napa Cabernet from a small family run estate in Calistoga. A real mouthful of wine.....\$2 / 6 / 12

A classic blend of Cab, Merlot, Cab Franc, Petit Verdot, Malbec and Syrah that's both elegant and powerful.....\$2.5 / 7.5 / 15

Harvested when the grapes freeze on the vine then crushed before thawing, intense aromas of melon, peach and golden apples.....\$12
